You may be able to receive up to \$2,000 per month, for multiple months.

Am I protected from eviction?

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued an eviction moratorium through Dec. 31 for people impacted by COVID-19. If eligible, submit the declaration form to your landlord to avoid an eviction. You can find that form at pima.gov/RentHelp.

How do I apply for rent assistance?

If you lost income because of COVID-19, apply online at housing.az.gov or call toll free 2-1-1 to apply via telephone.

Landlords can apply, too!

If an eviction has been initiated, or would have been if not for the Eviction Moratorium, ask your landlord to apply for Pima County CARES Act funding on your behalf. The application process for this program is easy, and the landlord can receive rent owed back to March.
