## **Maricopa Community Colleges Foundation Chicanos Por La Causa Scholarship**

The CPLC/MCCC Scholarship Program is awarded to outstanding Latino students pursuing an associate's degree or transfer program at any of the 10 Maricopa Community Colleges. This scholarship varies from \$500 to \$1000 per academic year and can be renewed for one additional year for a total of two years. This is a highly competitive scholarship. Each year, CPLC receives more than 500 eligible applications; of these, we are able to award approximately 15 scholarships.

Ideal applicants are highly-motivated individuals with clearly-defined educational and career goals and a demonstrated commitment to community service.

### **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ALL APPLICANTS:**

1. Must have graduated from Arizona HS or have a GED
2. Must be admitted to a Maricopa Community College and have an ID number
3. Must be enrolled in an associate's degree or bachelor's degree transfer program
4. Must be a full-time student
5. Must hold a minimum 2.5 GPA
6. Must have completed less than 64 credit hours
7. Cannot be receiving other MCCC institutional scholarship
8. Applicants do not need to be listed as Arizona Residents to apply.

### **APPLICATION DATES**

- Application opens February 1<sup>st</sup> 2017
- Applications due March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2017
- Scholarships awarded in June

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applications are thoroughly reviewed and scored by CPLC's Scholarship Committee. All applications must be submitted online through Maricopa's online scholarship application portal, located here: <https://mcccdf.academicworks.com>.

Applications received by any other method (hand-delivered, mailed, or emailed) will not be scored. Access to this portal is only available during the February 1<sup>st</sup> – March 3<sup>rd</sup> application window.
